

Division 19 Student Travel Award

The Division of Military Psychology (Division 19) of the American Psychological Association sponsors an annual competition for Military Psychology Student Travel Awards. The purpose of the Travel Award program is to help students interested in military psychology travel to the annual APA Convention to present their research. The division will award two \$750 travel awards to graduate/undergraduate students presenting paper/posters in Division 19. Graduate and undergraduate students are encouraged to apply. All application materials must be submitted no later than May 1, 2009.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicants must be enrolled in good standing, in a graduate/undergraduate program in psychology.
2. Applicants must be student affiliates Division 19 of the American Psychological Association. Students who are not affiliates should apply for affiliation when submitting materials for the Travel Award; the Student Travel Award Committee must receive all materials in a complete package.
3. Only students with papers/posters accepted by Division 19 will be considered. Multiple author submissions are acceptable, but the student applicant must be designated as the first author of the paper/poster. If there are multiple student authors, only the first author may apply for these funds. If the student-applicant has been accepted to present more than one paper or poster, he/she must choose only one paper/poster presentation for consideration when applying for this award.

PROCESS:

1. Student Awards Committee will examine all applications for eligibility.
2. Applicants must complete the application form. Submit the typed application form with the following materials:
 - A. 1-page maximum typed cover letter describing your research interests and experience, as well as career plans.
 - B. 1000-word summary of the research to be presented.
 - C. 2-page maximum Curriculum Vitae including scientific publications and presentations.
 - D. 1-page maximum letter of recommendation from your academic advisor or professor.
 - E. A copy of the letter of acceptance for the paper/poster.
3. In addition to the application form, applicants must submit a set of 3 additional collated copies. Each applicant should keep a copy of the submitted materials.
4. Decisions will be based on the quality of the submitted information. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
5. Award recipients will be announced on July 15, 2009. Funds will be provided directly to the students following the announcement of the award recipients.
6. Each recipient must submit a copy of the final presentation along with a letter of verification of convention participation that must be signed by the chair or head of the Department by September 30, 2009.

Division 19 Military Psychology Research Grant

The Division of Military Psychology (Division 19) of the American Psychological Association announces its annual competition for Military Psychology Research Grants. The purpose of the Military Psychology Research Grant program is to assist graduate/undergraduate students of psychology with costs associated with conducting research. This annual award will be presented to students whose research reflects excellence in military psychology. All materials must be submitted by May 1, 2009.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicants must be enrolled, in good standing in a graduate/undergraduate program in psychology.
2. Applicants must be student affiliates of Division 19. Students who are not affiliates must apply for affiliation when submitting materials for this Award; the Military Psychology Research Grant Committee must receive all materials in a complete package.
3. Applicants must have had their proposals approved by a faculty advisor prior to application.
4. The proposed research may be in any area of interest dealing with military psychology.

PROCESS:

1. Military Psychology Research Award Committee will examine all applications for eligibility.
2. Applicants must complete the Division 19 Military Psychology Research Award Form. The application form must be typed and submitted with the following materials:
 - A. 1-page maximum typed cover letter describing your research interests, experience, and career plans.
 - B. 5-page maximum summary of the research, including an explanation of research design and other important aspects of the project, and a brief explanation of proposed use of funds (i.e., a budget). The award must be used to support expenses that are directly related to the research (e.g., computer time, animal care, equipment, participant fees); it may not be used for tuition, travel, or personal expenses. PLEASE NOTE: Figures or tables may be included only if they can be incorporated into the 5-page research summary. The research summary must not exceed the 5-page limit including budget details and any figures or tables.
 - C. 2-page maximum Curriculum Vitae including scientific publications and presentations.
 - D. 1-page maximum letter of recommendation from your academic advisor or professor.
3. In addition to the application form, applicants must submit 3 additional collated copies. Each applicant should keep a copy of the submitted materials.
4. Decisions will be based upon the quality of the submitted information. Panels of psychologists representing the breadth of military psychology will make funding recommendations to the Military Psychology Research Award Committee.
5. Award recipients will be announced during the Division 19 Business Meeting at APA. Funds will be provided directly to students following the announcement of the award recipients.
6. Each award recipient must submit a 1-page report specifying how the funds were used on August of the following year. The report must be co-signed by the chair or head of the Department.
