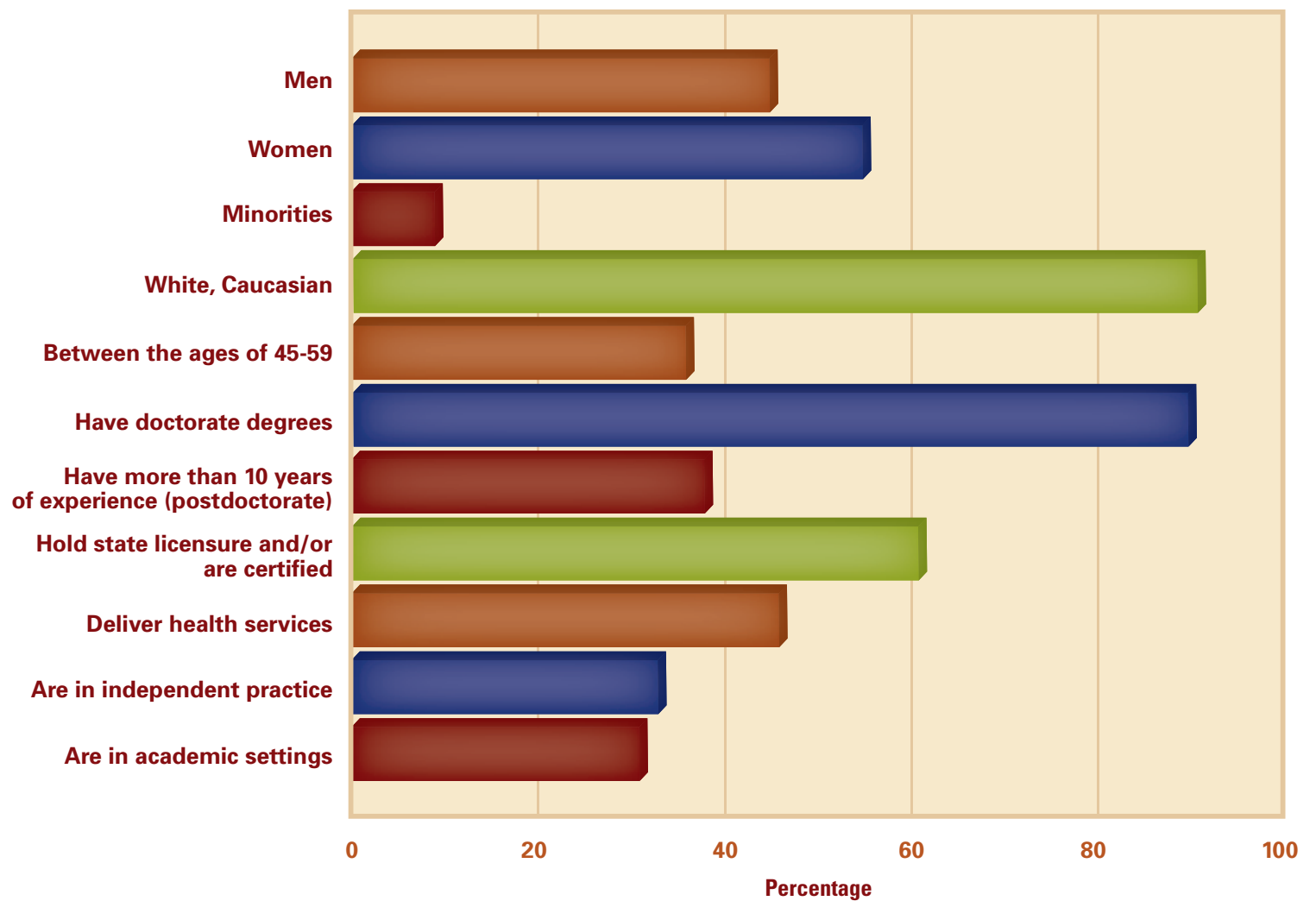


A Demographic Profile

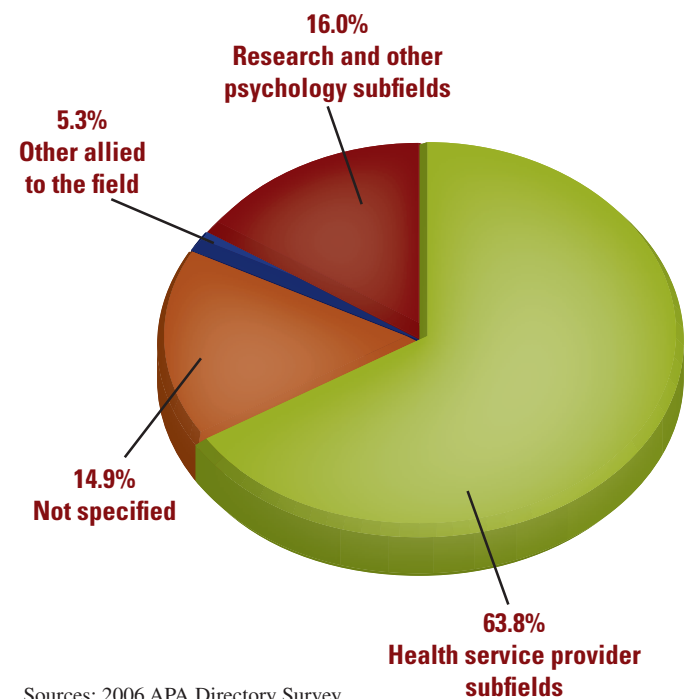
