## Connecting Mental and Physical Health

Pregnancy, miscarriage, postpartum depression, and integrating behavioral services into primary healthcare practice are but a few areas where APF provides support for psychology to improve our lives and well-being.

## Postpartum Depression

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, an estimated 12 percent of women report experiencing moderate depression after having a baby and an additional 6 percent report being very depressed. Postpartum Depression (PPD) not only affects new mothers, but also has ramifications for the entire family. APF's *Dorothy W. Cantor Fund* has awarded a grant to the American Psychological Association's Women's Program Office (WPO) to raise awareness about this important disorder. Through APF's funding, WPO will be able to disseminate a brochure in Spanish, French, and Chinese that identifies symptoms, discusses prevention, and explains treatment of PPD.

These brochures will be available on the web, and are being distributed to mental health and primary care providers' offices, community health centers, grassroots organizations, and governmental agencies.

## The Grief of Miscarriage

Preparing a nursery, buying baby clothes, anticipating a new life—all are dashed when a woman experiences a miscarriage.

In an effort to help establish coping mechanisms, support systems, and a better understanding of the mental health effects of miscarriage, APF has awarded the 2008 *Henry P. David Research Grant* to Lisa Rosenzweig, a graduate student at Teachers College at Columbia University. She will explore the largely unstudied area of relationship-specific social support systems on grief, and she hopes to uncover information that mental and medical health professionals can use to help patients dealing with pregnancy loss.

## Evans Receives APF Cummings PSYCHE Prize



Dr. Joseph H. Evans, Director of Pediatric Psychology at the Munroe-Meyer Institute (MMI) and Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Nebraska Medical Center, was named the recipient of the 2008 APF Cummings PSYCHE Prize.

Dr. Evans has spent the last 20 years establishing innovative healthcare delivery systems in rural settings, focusing on the

integration of behavioral services into primary health care practice. Dr. Evans' work in this area began when he asked himself, "Since integrated care is such a logical way to increase the availability of behavioral health services for greater numbers of patients, why isn't the approach being more widely adopted, particularly in rural areas?" Answering that question led Dr. Evans to establish 20 integrated behavioral health clinics in pediatric primary care settings across Nebraska. Thanks to Dr. Evans' vision, patients from more than 225 different Nebraska communities and towns have been served in integrated behavioral health clinics.

Over the next five years, Dr. Evans plans to use the \$50,000 prize to expand the number of Behavioral Health Clinics in Nebraska, establish training programs, and replicate the MMI Behavioral Health Clinics training program in other states.

The Nicholas and Dorothy Cummings Foundation established the Prize to recognize a psychologist whose career has expanded the role of the psychologist as a primary care provider working side-by-side with primary care physicians in the setting of organized systems of healthcare delivery.

FLORENCE W. KASLOW, PhD

#### Florence W. Kaslow, PhD,

*Gold Medal Award for Life Achievement in the Practice of Psychology*

Florence Kaslow's foresight in establishing and serving as first President of the American Board of Forensic Psychology advanced this specialty field. Her involvement as President of the Division of Family Psychology, in formalizing the Journal of Family Psychology, in founding the International Family Therapy Association, and in serving as President of the International Academy of Family Psychologists are all testaments to her dynamic energy; inclusive, stimulating leadership style, and "can do" philosophy. Dr. Kaslow is considered an outstanding and versatile teacher, clinician, editor, author, consultant, coach, and radio and TV guest.

#### Alice H. Eagly, PhD

*Gold Medal Award for Life Achievement in the Science of Psychology*

As a scholar, her forward-looking vision is always securely grounded in recognition of past contributions of others. Through innovation and careful scholarship, she has kept the psychology of gender in the mainstream eye of the field. As a mark of her contribution, she has generated for others the conceptual and methodological tools needed to carry on this impressive body of work. Alice H. #### Raymond D. Fowler, PhD,

*Gold Medal Award for Life Achievement in Psychology in the Public Interest*

For half a century, Dr. Fowler has applied the principles of psychology to a broad spectrum of social and professional issues. As a young psychologist during the civil rights movement, Fowler helped to reduce racial tensions in Alabama and to promote interracial dialogue. He was instrumental in the restructuring of the Alabama mental health system and, later, the Alabama prison system. As APA president, and later as Chief Executive Officer, he facilitated APA's financial recovery and found innovative ways to bring disparate factions together.

#### Theodore Millon, PhD

*Gold Medal Award for Life Achievement in the Application of Psychology*

Over the past 40 years Dr. Millon set a foundation for integrating the four elements constituting a mature clinical science: theory, taxonomy, instrumentation, and intervention. He has sought to enrich and coordinate each element with impeccable logic. Sophisticated in adjacent scientific disciplines, he constructed his theory to be anchored to evolutionary principles, from which he then derived an innovative taxonomy of maladaptive personality styles, as well as their developmental pathogenesis. The theory and its taxonomy were then creatively operationalized with empirically grounded assessment instruments, producing data-guiding and personalized therapeutic interventions.

## Plous honored as 2008 distinguished teacher

**Scott Plous, PhD,** is the recipient of the 2008 APF Charles L. Brewer Distinguishing Teaching of Psychology Award.

This award celebrates Scott Plous as a master teacher, developer of premier Internet resources in psychology, and pioneer of action teaching. At Wesleyan University, Plous is known as an extraordinary lecturer and dedicated mentor of teachers. He is also the founder of Social Psychology Network, a set of innovative web sites used each day by thousands of students and instructors. And he has advocated socially engaged 'action teaching' that leads not only to a better understanding of psychology but also to a more just and peaceful world.

Dr. Plous will deliver *Action Teaching: What It Is and How It Can Improve Almost Any Psychology Course* at the APA Convention on Friday, August 15, at 11:00am.

## David and Carol Myers Make \$200,000 Gift

Dr. David and Mrs. Carol Myers have pledged \$200,000 to support APF's International Union of Psychological Science (IUPsyS) Fund. The Fund supports the educational and programmatic activities of the IUPsyS to further the development of psychological science and psychological scientists in low-income, transitional, and developing countries.

Dr. Myers is a noted philanthropist. He explains his most recent gift: "I was impressed and

inspired when reading the *Monitor's* announcement of Bruce Overmier's leadership and generosity in establishing an APF fund to assist the International Union of Psychological Science in supporting the professional development of our colleagues in developing countries. Supporting Bruce's vision seemed a fitting way by which my wife, Carol, and I might give something back to our discipline, with a focus on those in lower income, underserved regions. This is also a gesture of thanks for the support I have received from teaching colleagues worldwide."

## First Responders: Healing through Delayed Debriefing



In late 2007, APF awarded the University of Nebraska-Lincoln a grant to address the psychological needs of first responders, in an effort to prevent their suffering from Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).

PTSD often manifests itself through flashbacks, symptoms of avoidance, and symptoms of hyperarousal. Whereas most research calls for immediate intervention after traumatic events, new studies are finding that delayed intervention may actually be more effective; PTSD can occur months or years after an initial traumatic event.

Robin Chang, a graduate student leading the project, is currently working to determine when psychological intervention is most effective. The results of his work could potentially lead to improved forms of treatment for the approximately 7.7 million people diagnosed with PTSD per year, including first responders, rape victims, those who have been in a car wreck, war veterans, and natural disaster survivors.
