



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

APF Division 17 Counseling Psychology Grants

The American Psychological Foundation (APF) provides financial support of innovative research and programs that enhance the power of psychology to elevate the human condition and advance human potential both now and in generations to come.

The Counseling Psychology grant program was established in 1998 in conjunction with APA Division 17 (Society for Counseling Psychology) and sponsors activities to enhance the science and practice of counseling psychology.

Amount:

Up to \$5,000 will be available in 2009.

Goals of the Program:

- Support scientific, literary or educational activities to enhance the science and practice of counseling psychology
- Support research on the implementation of innovative counseling programs and models

Eligibility:

Applicants must be:

- Members of APA Division 17 (Society of Counseling Psychology) and
- Educational institutions or a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations or affiliated with such an organization.

APF encourages applications from individuals who represent diversity in race, ethnicity, gender, age, disability, and sexual orientation.

Application Process:

Proposals should describe the proposed project and respond to the following questions in 5-10 pages:

- What is the project's goal? Please provide a work plan and timeline.
- How is the sponsoring organization qualified to conduct this project?
- What other organizations and/or funders are involved in the project? What are their contributions to the work?
- How does the proposed project relate to the applicant organization's mission?
- Whom will this project serve?
- What are the intended outcomes, and how will the project achieve them?
- What is the geographic scope of the proposed project?
- What is the total cost of the project? Please provide a detailed budget.
