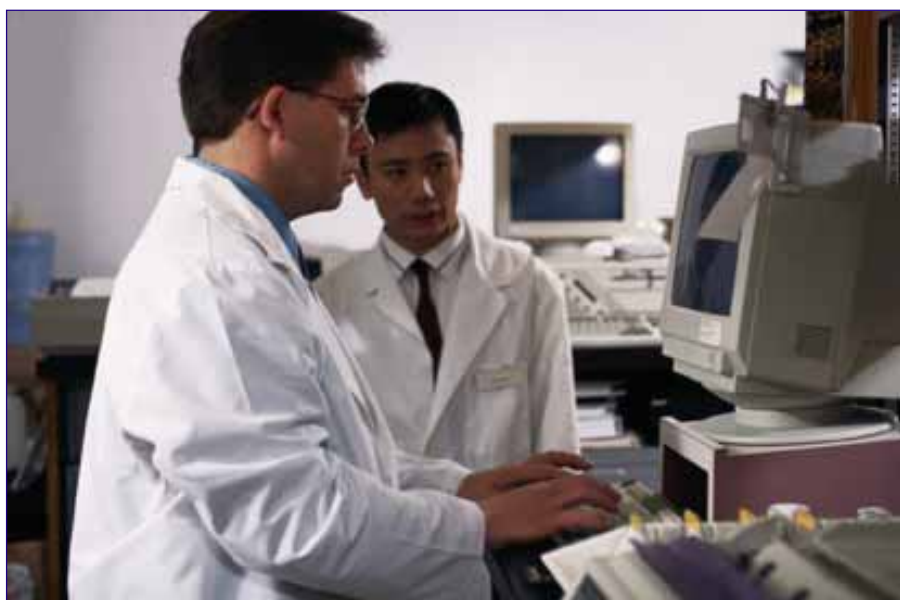

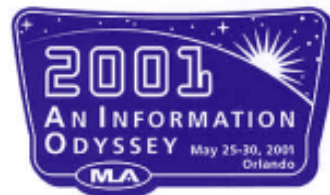

## Sixteen APA Journals Available in PsycARTICLES Named "Journals of the 20th Century"

### Study in The Serials Librarian Identifies Most Significant Titles in Psychology

A study published recently in a major professional journal in library science lists 16 APA journals among 30 "Journals of the [20<sup>th</sup>] Century" in psychology.

The journals were identified by author by Daniel E. Burgard (MSLIS, Illinois) in his article "Journals of the Century in Psychology," [*The Serials Librarian* Vol. 39(3) 2001], published in late March.

Mr. Burgard is Instructional Services Librarian in the Gibson D. Lewis Health Science Library at the University of North Texas and former Psychology Subject Specialist in the Education and Social Science Library at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

According to the article, his methodology for identifying the journals included analysis of citation data from the Institute for Scientific Information's *Journal Citation Report*, as well as other factors such as the longevity of the publications

and their sustained importance to the most scholars throughout most of the century.

"This study attests to the success of APA's efforts throughout the last century to enhance the dissemination of scientific information in psychology," said Gary R. VandenBos, PhD, the APA Publisher.

"It also challenges the authors and editors who currently contribute to our journals program with an august legacy to live up to and expand upon in our new century."

Electronic access to these journals via the PsycARTICLES full-text database will empower scholars with new, untapped research capabilities.

Currently, 13 years of APA journals are available electronically, and APA is committed to digitizing all back issues. Once completed, this enhancement will enable psychologists to raise the historical understanding of behavioral and mental health topics to an unprecedented level. ■

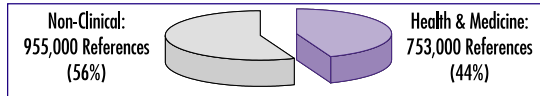

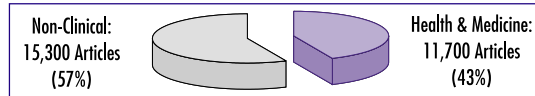
