## Mark Stover Receives APA's Excellence in Librarianship Award



Dr. Mark Stover was awarded the American Psychological Association's Excellence in Librarianship Award at the Educational & Behavioral Sciences Section (EBSS) Research Forum at the annual meeting of the American Library Association on June 23, 2007.

Stover is the Assistant University Librarian for Research Services at San Diego State University (SDSU) Library and is one of the 2006-07 recipients of the San Diego State University Alumni Association Award for Outstanding Faculty Contributions. He is also the editor of *Behavioral & Social Sciences Librarian*, the former president of the Association of Mental Health

Librarians, and a member of the California Academic Research Librarians and the Association of Jewish Libraries.

Stover became interested in librarianship while working as a student assistant in the university library. "I've always enjoyed helping people, and this, together with my love of computers and books, brought me to a career where I could combine all of these passions."

One of Stover's early professional positions put him on the path with a focus in psychology librarianship. "One of my first professional jobs as a librarian was at Phillips Graduate Institute, which has graduate programs in marital and family therapy, organizational behavior, and school psychology," he said. "This led to my position as psychology librarian at San Diego State University, where psychology is one of the largest majors on campus. While I am not a psychologist, I do enjoy both the scientific aspects of psychology as well as the 'people-oriented' aspects. It has been a good fit and a great career."

The APA award recognized Stover for the development of San Diego State's Test Finder tool, an electronic database for finding psychosocial tests and measures. He was inspired to create this tool by Helen Hough at the University of Texas who created an online index of psychosocial test compendia. "I adapted her approach and then decided to expand the scope of the project to index monographs and edited works that might contain a small number of complete tests. After researching the journal literature, I found that there were hundreds of complete instruments that were 'hidden' in journal articles.

When discovered, these instruments can be used by students, researchers, and clinicians, within the constraints of copyright, of course." Test Finder provides comprehensive access to these resources.

Stover continues to update and maintain Test Finder. "Currently, I am working on providing online subject access using a controlled vocabulary to Test Finder, which is a huge task," he said.

Upon receiving the award, Stover took the opportunity to speak for librarians everywhere. "I am honored to receive this award," he said at the June meeting. "All librarians know that individual awards like this are never fully deserved, because so much of our work is done collaboratively. My thanks go to the folks at the American Psychological Association, who created

and funded this award, and have shown their appreciation for all librarians serving students and researchers in the behavioral sciences."

## About the Award

The American Psychological Association's Excellence in Librarianship Award was created to recognize significant contributions or research within psychology and social sciences librarianship. The award is open to both mid-career librarians and allied professionals (10 or more years of experience) who have demonstrated significant achievement in librarianship in psychology or the social sciences. # An Interview with Alice Perez Teaching Students to Use PsycINFO®

PsycINFO is always interested in how librarians are teaching the databases at their institutions. We recently spoke with Alice Perez at the Social Sciences and Humanities Library at the University of California, San Diego (UCSD) about her experiences using and teaching PsycINFO. Ms. Perez is the library liaison and bibliographer for Psychology, Cognitive Science, and the Education Studies program. In this capacity, she provides library skills and research techniques training to students in the psychology and cognitive science departments. The library subscribes to PsycINFO and PsycARTICLES® on ProQuest's CSA Illumina platform.

The APA databases are used by a number of disciplines at UCSD including psychology, education, cognitive science, human devel-

opment, linguistics, medicine, and more. Both PsycINFO and PsycARTICLES are "well-received by faculty and students." The library allows patrons to access the databases and full-text articles remotely. Upon learning about the journal backfiles added to PsycARTICLES last year, a graduate student responded "Awesome!"

Ms. Perez teaches both undergraduate and graduate students and tailors her instruction to fit each group.

"Undergraduates must first learn what a database is," says Perez. Then, she shows students how to identify key concepts in their research topics and how to use the *Thesaurus of Psychological Index Terms*® to find descriptors for these concepts. She also explains the difference between keyword and descriptor searching and how to

use Boolean operators to construct a search.

Graduate students receive similar instruction if necessary, but "psychology graduate students usually have more experience searching PsycINFO, therefore, I focus more on advanced searching techniques of the database, such as Boolean operators and wildcard symbols," she says. Her graduate instruction also includes information on how to set up alerts and how to browse individual journal issues in PsycARTICLES.

Ms. Perez prefers to teach students in classrooms with workstations to allow them to do hands-on searching of PsycINFO. She keeps her sessions informal and interacts with the students during the class.

# Refining Results in APA PsycNET®

The American Psychological Association's redesigned search platform, APA PsycNET, features a number of new and enhanced functionalities that address the needs of a wide range of searchers, including students, faculty, researchers, and librarians.

Although it is important to provide sophisticated search technologies for expert searchers, many users simply type a word or two into the search box and hit "Search." Particularly in a database the size of PsycINFO, the results can be overwhelming. Two new features added to APA PsycNET, **Search within Results** and **Narrow Results by**, give the user the opportunity to refine their search results on the results page itself.

**Search within Results** allows users to add search terms to their current results to narrow down to more relevant hits.

**Narrow Results by** is an at-a-glance overview of the search results and gives searchers several options to quickly narrow their results to relevant records.

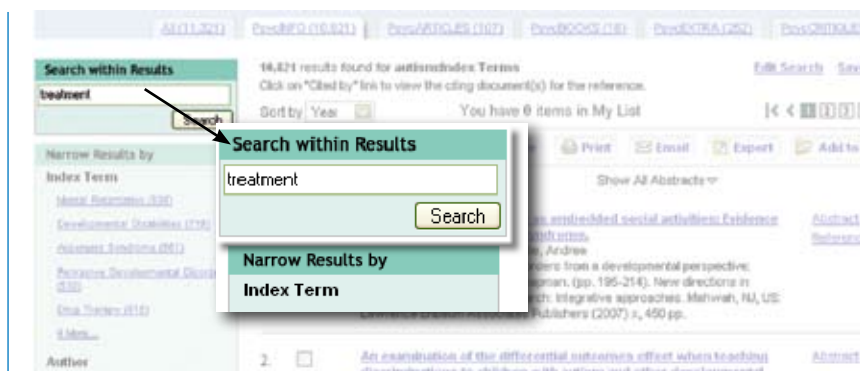
Although these new tools provide a quick, convenient method for refining searches for anyone searching APA PsycNET, novice searchers may find these features useful as a discovery tool to build more advanced searches.

The **Narrow Results by** list displays the top ten most frequently occurring

- ❖ Index Terms
- ❖ Authors
- ❖ Publication Types
- ❖ Journal/Book Titles
- ❖ Years
- ❖ Age Groups
- ❖ Population Groups

## Search Example

If you were to search for "Autism" in the **Index Terms** field, you would get more than 10,000 results. After you scan the results, perhaps you realize you are only interested in articles about the treatment of autism. To narrow your results, type "treatment" in the **Search within Results** box.



Your results list will be redisplayed to show articles concerning the treatment of autism. You also have the option to further refine your results. Perhaps you want to see only empirical studies about the treatment of autism. To do this, scroll down the **Narrow Results By** list until you come to **Methodology** and select "empirical study".



You have now narrowed your original search on autism to empirical studies about the treatment of autism. You can continue narrowing using these tools until you find manageable results. ■

## Open Access Journal Coverage in PsycINFO

One of the most common coverage questions PsycINFO gets is “what is your policy on covering open access journals?” According to the Directory of Open Access Journals, these periodicals are “journals that use a funding model that does not charge readers or their institutions for access.” Over the past few years, changes in the publishing technology and public policy have created an environment in which the number and importance of open access journals has grown.

There is no difference in the way PsycINFO considers open access journals as compared to traditional journals. To be covered in PsycINFO, a journal must

- ❖ Be relevant to psychology.
- ❖ Be of a quality and scope of interest to an international audience.
- ❖ Be peer reviewed.
- ❖ Have an ISSN.
- ❖ Follow standard conventions for scholarly journals.
- ❖ Contain usable abstracts, titles, and keywords in English.
- ❖ Demonstrate diversity of reviewers and authors.
- ❖ Include all or mostly all original articles.
- ❖ Contain articles that are substantiated with empirical data or other means.
- ❖ Be published on a regular schedule appropriate for the established frequency of the journal.

Up until recently, staff did not even collect data on a journal's revenue model (such as subscriptions, page charges, advertisements). The quality and usability of the articles in a journal is paramount to any coverage consideration for PsycINFO.

Making our coverage lists more usable for today's audience, however, requires a bit more thought about this issue. Applying the definition of open access can be difficult as different organizations apply this label to different types of access models. The journals listed here, however, conform to most definitions of open access:

She always ends classes with a quiz, which reinforces the skills learned during class.

To support her instruction at UCSD, Ms. Perez has created a number of training materials and tutorials. She uses worksheets during classes to help students develop concepts for their research questions and to teach them to organize their citations. She also distributes bookmarks with descriptions of how to use Boolean operators and wildcard symbols. Ms. Perez has worked with the library's electronic services librarian to create a logo for all her handouts and support materials.

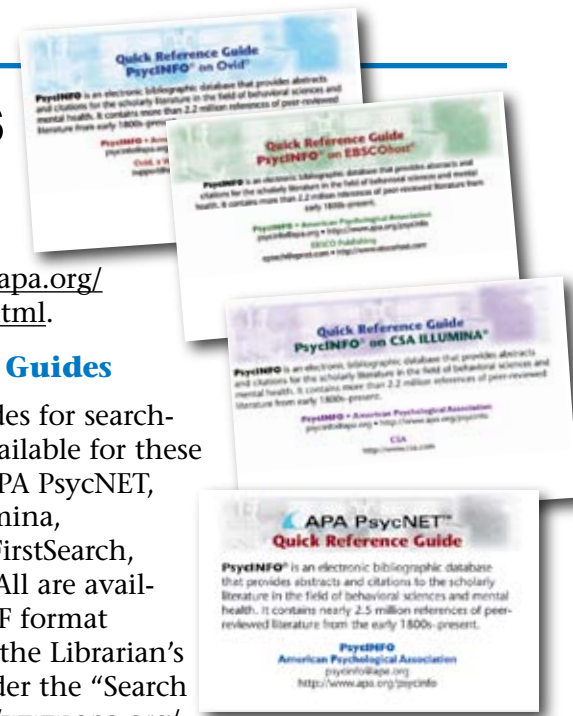
