AWARD NOMINATION PROCEDURES

Any member of SPSMM may make a nomination. All nomination materials must be submitted in one complete packet by the nominator to the Awards Committee Chair. This packet should include four copies of the following:

- A cover letter detailing the award and the person being nominated
- Two letters of support from individuals other than the nominator
- The nominee's vita (if available)
- A phone number where the nominated person can be reached (can be included in the cover letter)
- Researcher of the Year nominations should indicate publications for which the nominee is being honored. This information can be detailed in the cover letter, or in a separate document.
