

What is required for Fellowship:

New Fellows both to APA and the Division:

- + Evidence of unusual contributions or outstanding performance in the field of psychology at a level beyond that of being a good practitioner, teacher, administrator, or scholar.
- + Evidence of national impact beyond the local, state or regional levels (which are not of themselves sufficient to qualify for a national recognition) by significant, sustained involvement at that level or by significant contributions to national policy development or political advocacy in favor of Public Sector Psychology
- + Endorsement by three or more APA fellows of whom some ought to be from Div 18

APA Fellows – already members of the Division who would like to become Fellows of Division 18:

- + Copy of your CV
- + Statement of your work and contributions to Public Service Psychology as above
