The membership in Division 18 has gradually increased over the past three years, with 1160 members in 2004, 1239 in 2005, and 1290 in 2006—a total increase of 130 members over the past three years. In 2006, 111 new members joined in all categories, which was fewer than the 163 members that joined in 2005. However, many fewer members chose to resign in 2006, which accounts for the overall increase. Finally, membership increases were roughly the same across the five sections of the Division, with Psychologists in Indian Country being the one exception.

First-year Members, Affiliates, and Student Affiliates, along with Dues-Exempt Members who receive the newsletter are billed each year. For 2006, income from these sources totaled \$5710, which was less than last year, but significantly above the funds raise in 2004. In summary, the Division is doing well in both in terms of membership recruitment and retention, which is against the general trend for APA Divisions.
