Student Scholar Latina/Hispanic Woman Award

The purpose of the *Student Scholar Latina/Hispanic Woman Award* is to honor the scholarly contributions of a Division 35 student member who has conducted research and/or scholarly work that advances the psychology of Latina/Hispanic women. Submissions for consideration may include products based on degree-related work (e.g., dissertations) or other projects (class papers).

Nomination Requirements:

- Division 35 Student members who are currently enrolled in graduate training
- A letter of reference from the student's advisor or faculty mentor who can verify enrollment, address the merits of the student-initiated and –developed product, provide a general reference about the nominee, and attend to the nominee's commitment and potential for advancing Latina's / Hispanic women's issues.
- Electronic submission (via email attachment) of the following files:
 - 2-3 page letter of application addressing project (include full contact information)
 - 100 word abstract of scholarly product
 - Copy of the scholarly product
- All materials should be forwarded to Alberta M. Gloria at agloria@education.wisc.edu by **18 February 2008**.

Evaluation and Award Notification:

- Application materials will be evaluated by a three-member committee (Section President and two committee members) on:
 - Scholarly merit (theoretical conceptualization, methodology)
 - Practice and research implications
 - Overall contributions to advancing the psychology of Latina/Hispanic women
- Applicants will be notified via email regarding status of their application materials.

Distribution of Award:

- The award winner will receive a certificate of achievement, monetary award, and recognition at APA.
- The award winner's name and 100-word abstract of the winning product will be posted on the Section III webpage and in the Division 35 Newsletter.
