By the date of this report, decisions will have been reached on most of these manuscripts. ^b The rejection rate indicates the chance of ultimate acceptance by a journal. Most manuscripts are rejected initially; then, after some number of revisions, a certain number are finally accepted. A rejection rate of, say, 77% means that manuscripts submitted to that journal have a 23% chance of ultimately being accepted. The average rejection rate was calculated by dividing total acceptances by total submissions (with pending manuscripts factored out) and subtracting from 100%; it is not an average of the journal averages. ^c Includes articles, brief reports, case reports, discussions, monographs, and brief substantive items. For the secondary journals, these items are abstracts. ^d Includes tables of contents and author indexes. ^e For these journals, data for the editors and incoming editors were combined in order to reflect activity for the journals as a whole. ^f Includes award addresses, correction notices, editorials, obituaries, and instructions.
