

Diversity Project 2000 – Summer Institute

The Diversity Project 2000 (DP2000) Summer Institute will convene August 4-8, 2000, in Washington, DC. As in the past, students of color from community colleges across the United States and from the local APA convention area will participate in the 4-day summer institute. Sponsors include the National Institute of Drug Abuse, Psi Beta (the national honor society in psychology for students in community and junior colleges), and APA.

The primary objective of the DP2000 is to increase the number of undergraduate students of color majoring in psychology through mentoring and leadership activities at the local, regional, and national levels. The DP2000 Summer Institute component was designed by Psi Beta in collaboration with APA's OEMA.
