

## ARTICLE SPONSORSHIP FORM

The American Psychological Association (APA) has developed policies to allow authors who publish in APA journals to comply with the manuscript archiving requirements for Wellcome Trust.

Authors publishing in APA journals can comply with Wellcome Trust's policies by paying a subsidy fee to APA to help offset the costs of peer review, editing, and production costs. The fee has been set at \$4,000 per article for all APA journals.

Upon final publication, APA will send PubMed Central (PMC) the final document that will also appear in PsycARTICLES, APA's online full-text article database. APA will authorize its public posting on PMC, and PMC mirror sites, immediately. PMC and PMC mirror sites will also link directly to the article in PsycARTICLES. APA will also make the article freely available to the public on the APA Journals website.

### Supplemental Terms and Conditions for Sponsored Manuscript Submissions

The American Psychological Association (APA) has, through certain arrangements with funding agencies including the Wellcome Trust, agreed to post sponsored final documents (hereafter referred to as “documents”) used to generate the definitive published journal article, to PubMed Central (PMC) or PMC mirror sites for non-commercial purposes only.

Documents posted to PMC are protected by copyright and are posted to PMC by permission of APA. At the time of deposit, posted documents included all changes made during peer review, copyediting, and publishing. PMC and PMC mirror site host sites are responsible for all links within the document and for incorporating any publisher-supplied amendments or retractions as subsequently issued. For a document that has been sponsored, the published journal article, guaranteed to be such by APA, is available for free to non-subscribers.
