### **Nomination Procedures for DSCA and DSAAP**

- ◆ A letter of nomination that addresses the following questions:

- (1) Describe the important theoretical and empirical contributions and their impact on the field, usually attributed to the nominee.
- (2) Compare the nominee with others in her/his field, including others who previously have received the Distinguished Scientific Contribution Award.
- (3) What influences has the nominee had on students and others in the same field of study? Where possible, please identify the nominee's students by name.

- ◆ Attach the following:

- (1) a current vitae, including grant support, honors, editorial and other professional service, and a complete bibliography (if not part of the vitae)
- (2) names and addresses of several scientists familiar with the nominee's work
- (3) list of ten most significant and representative publications
- (4) at least three reprints representative of the nominee's contribution (All material can be submitted electronically, especially reprints.)

### **Nomination Procedures for Early Career Award (ECA)**

- ◆ For the 2010 program, nominations of persons who received doctoral degrees during and since 2000 are being sought in the areas of:

~ animal learning and behavior, comparative      ~developmental psychology  
~psychopathology      ~cognition and human learning  
~health psychology

- ◆ Please submit the following electronically:

- 1) letter of nomination (two pages maximum length)
- 2) a current vita and a complete bibliography (if not part of the vita)
- 3) no more than five reprints representative of the nominee's contributions
