Adults and Children Together (ACT) Raising Safe Kids Program is a universal parenting program designed to promote positive parenting and prevent child maltreatment by fostering knowledge and skills that change or improve parenting practices. It is endorsed as a promising practice to *prevent child abuse and neglect* by the California Evidence-Based Clearinghouse. The program is delivered by trained and certified **ACT** Facilitators in 9 sessions of 2-hour each on average.

The **ACT** program addresses

- Parents' use of effective, nonviolent discipline and nurturing behaviors.
- Parental knowledge of child development, discipline methods, and media literacy
- Parents' anger management, social problem solving skills and their ability to teach/model these skills to children
- Effective strategies to manage children's aggression and behavior problems
