

TOP 20 BADGES RUBRIC: CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT

Format: The following must be complete and included in the submission for the application to be reviewed:

- Two-page written overview statement discussing how each of the two principles is addressed in the application and the nature of the evidence showing that each one is applied school wide.
- 1-2 pieces of evidence for EACH principle attached to application.
- Plan for continuous improvement included for each principle.

Principle 16	Shows awareness of principle but no evidence is presented, or the evidence reveals misinterpretation of the principle	Shows awareness of principle; provides some evidence that principle is incorporated in classrooms	Shows awareness of principle; provides evidence that principle is incorporated in classrooms school-wide	Shows awareness of principle; provides strong evidence of school wide implementation of that principle and how application of that principle could be maintained and enhanced in the future.	
Principle 17	Shows awareness of principle but no evidence is presented, or the evidence reveals misinterpretation of the principle	Shows awareness of principle, provides some evidence that principle is incorporated in classrooms	Shows awareness of principle; provides evidence that principle is incorporated in classrooms school-wide	Shows awareness of principle; provides strong evidence of school wide implementation of that principle and how application of that principle could be maintained and enhanced in the future.	

Badge determination:

If an application scores a 1 in any category (General Submission Presentation, Written Overview Statement, each of the principles), or more than one 2, no badge will be awarded.

2-year badge earned: Shows overall awareness of the principles and has provided evidence of integration throughout the school.

3-year badge earned: Shows overall awareness of principles and has provided evidence of school wide integration and a clear plan for continuous improvement.
