

## (Re-)Designing Multi-Session &/or Hybrid CE Programs

Sponsors may decide to offer CE programs that occur within a multi-session format – which may in some cases be hybrid (homestudy and live components) or occur for several months (e.g., conferences, multi-day, modular); however, participants are not always able to attend extended and/or multi-component programming. In cases where longer and/or multi-session programs *could* be offered in shorter or discrete sessions without compromising the educational/pedagogical benefits, sponsors may want to consider such an option. This resource provides guidance for APA-approved sponsors of continuing education who want to retain flexibility when offering multi-session, hybrid, and/or extended-length programs, while also meeting the [Standards and Criteria](#).
