What is ILPP?

A unique opportunity for APA members to gain insights into psychology and mental health care across the world, learn from international colleagues and earn continuing education credits—all while taking the trip of a lifetime.

What do you learn during the trip?

The program facilitates the exchange of knowledge, ideas and resources, and fosters long-term international collaborations through professional visits and meetings with leaders in the field. Past programs included visits to university, hospital, clinical, community and governmental settings with focuses on addiction and rehabilitation, trauma, education, aging, policy, immigration, refugees and other areas of interest.

When can i join a trip to Tanzania?

The next trip will be in Tanzania, January 2nd to 13th 2024. This program includes professional visits to Zanzibar and Dar es Salaam as well as cultural and historical tours.

For now the cost is set to \$3550 including hotels, most meals, on ground transfers and excursions. Travelers purchase their own air tickets in addition.

Option for excursions to climb Kilimanjaro or Safari in the Serengeti available.

APA travelers have been asked to participate in a mini-congress and give 30-45min presentations on areas of expertise.
