THE AMERICAN PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION (APA) AND THE BARBADOS SOCIETY OF PSYCHOLOGY (BSP) AGREE AS FOLLOWS

WHEREAS,

the Bylaws of the APA and the Statutes of the BSP share mutual objectives calling for the advancement of the discipline in the public interest; and

WHEREAS,

APA and BSP have a shared commitment to the inherent dignity and advancement of equal rights of all people, recognizing human rights as the foundation of freedom, justice, and peace; and

WHEREAS,

it is desirable to strengthen and build upon the history of collaboration and exchange between the psychological organizations in the United States and Barbados; and

WHEREAS,

mutual concerns make it likely that occasions for joint consultation and cooperation will continue to present themselves in the years to come; and

WHEREAS,

both organizations wish to anticipate such occasions by establishing a framework, when possible, for their timely discussion;

NOW THEREFORE,

the APA and the BSP affirm and reaffirm their working relations in this Memorandum of Understanding.

FURTHERMORE,

pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding, the executives of the APA and the BSP shall maintain regular communication to discuss matters of common concern and agree to reconsider terms of this agreement as indicated.

FINALLY,

the APA and the BSP will seek to identify projects and activities in which they may work together, assist, or support one another, or otherwise cooperate for the betterment of psychology and the public interest.
