The American Psychological Association (APA) and the French National Committee for Scientific Psychology (Comité National Français de Psychologie Scientifique, CNFPS) agree as follows:

Whereas the Bylaws of the APA and the statutes of the CNFPS share mutual objectives calling for the advancement of the discipline in the public interest; and

Whereas it is desirable to have integration and exchange between the psychology organizations in the United States and France; and

Whereas mutual concerns make it likely that occasions for joint consultation and cooperation will present themselves in the years to come; and

Whereas both organizations wish to anticipate such occasions by establishing a framework, when possible, for their timely discussion;

Now therefore, the APA and the CNFPS affirm and reaffirm their working relations in this Memorandum of Understanding.


Furthermore, pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding, the executives of the APA and the CNFPS shall maintain regular communication to discuss matters of common concern.


