

Indexing Coverage Agreement

APA PsycInfo® is the major source of information for the world's literature in psychology and related fields. Millions of users around the world turn to PsycInfo to lead them to professional and technical journals, as well as books and dissertations. The PsycInfo database is an online discovery and linking tool that leads users to the primary content. Bibliographic records may also be included in subject-specific derivatives online and in print.

APA PsycTests® is a research database that provides information about psychological tests, measures, scales, surveys, and other assessments found in the scholarly literature. Where possible, the instrument is included with the description. PsycTests is a discovery and linking tool for psychological tests that leads users to key articles describing test development, review, or use.

The Publisher asserts that _____ (the
"Journal") is published according to common scholarly publication ethical standards, including (but not limited to):

- The Journal's peer-review process and any fees required for manuscript processing or other publication services are clearly stated in a place that is easy for potential authors to find prior to submitting their manuscripts for review.
- All members of the Journal's editorial and/or advisory board are recognized experts within the Journal's scope and have granted permission for their names to be used in conjunction with the publication.

If the Journal is accepted for coverage, the Publisher will supply access to an editorial copy of each issue of the Journal to PsycInfo with the understanding that selected articles from the Journal will be abstracted and indexed for inclusion in PsycInfo, which may be distributed in any language in any media worldwide in the PsycInfo database and any of its derivative products.

As they are published, access to the issues (or articles, if the journals do not publish issues) of the Journal will be provided to PsycInfo on a COMPLIMENTARY basis for coverage in PsycInfo. The provision of electronic files is required; print is not accepted.[‡]

If the Journal is accepted for coverage in PsycInfo, the Publisher gives permission for selected articles to be indexed in PsycTests. PsycTests will use the same complimentary subscription as PsycInfo for indexing.[†]

If the Journal is indexed in PsycTests, the Publisher gives permission for selected pieces of information (usually only a single table or appendix per article) to be reproduced in PsycTests. PsycTests will follow up with additional publishers or authors if there is a permissions notice on the specific item selected for reproduction.[†]

Unless earlier terminated by either party, this Agreement shall come into effect once signed by both parties and shall continue for an initial term of one year (the "Initial Term"). The Agreement shall thereafter automatically renew and remain in force for further terms of one year (a "Renewal Term") unless either Party gives thirty (30) days' notice to the other party of its intention to terminate this Agreement at the end of the Initial Term or any subsequent Renewal Term.
