


# Introducing a Newly Improved APA PsycNET® Platform

## What New Improvements Can You Expect?




### New Technology

- The APA PsycNET platform migrated to the cloud to improve performance and response time



### New Responsive Web Design

- A responsive new design properly renders content and functionality across all devices, making the need for a separate APA PsycNET mobile app obsolete
- Simplified and more intuitive navigation includes easy access to recent searches and My List in top level navigation across the platform
- Explicit label for the APA Thesaurus for improved findability (formerly called Term finder)



### Improved Search

- "Test Lookup" is a new search index for finding tests by name
- A more prominent placement for search tools is now located in the right rail (author, journal and test lookups)
- Search history is now directly accessible from the Advanced Search page

## Improved Browse

- Browse PsycARTICLES®
  - The Journal Browse list now includes journal covers, impact factors, years covered, and editor names
  - A new "Most popular" option in Journal Browse allows users to see the 25 Most Downloaded and 25 Most Cited articles from APA journals on APA PsycNET
  - Integrated into the journal table of contents (TOC) page, Journal Snapshots now provide data on most frequent authors, most cited articles, and other key information about a journal
- Browse PsycBOOKS®
  - "Latest release" is a new browse option for APA books
  - Edited book TOC pages now include references for chapters
- Browse PsycTESTS®
  - New Commercial and Non-Commercial browse options for tests
  - Each test listing now includes test versions, alternate names, test summary, and full test link where available

## Improved Citation Management

- Citations can now be added to My List directly from Browse
- New export function allows you to export citations directly to APA Style CENTRAL® – the award-winning APA online scholarly writing solution

- Full-record displays for PsycARTICLES, PsycBOOKS, and PsycINFO® now include a Related Content section listing the 5 most relevant records from APA databases, with a link to see up to 25 related records
