The average rejection rate for all journals is calculated by dividing total acceptances by total submissions (with pending manuscripts factored out) and subtracting from 100%. It is not an average of the individual journal rejection rates.

^d"Average lag in months" is calculated as the average time between acceptance and publication for all manuscripts published in 2010.
