## EDUCATION

APA PsycTests is a repository of psychological tests and instruments used for research. Educators and students can use this database to conduct, create, or measure research in the behavioral and psychological aspects of education. There are more than **6,200 APA PsycTests records** related to Education, Teaching, and Student Characteristics.

### Sample Search in APA PsycTests

**Scenario:** A student teacher is looking to develop a novel way to assess their bilingual students' progress at the end of the semester.

#### Thesaurus Terms

- Academic Achievement
- Bilingual Education
- English as Second Language
- Multicultural Education

#### Search Strategy

Using the Advanced Search option in APA PsycNet, select APA PsycTests from the list of databases and enter the following parameters:

- Multicultural Education in Index Terms
- OR Bilingual Education in Index Terms
- AND Achievement Measures in Index Terms
- OR Academic Achievement in Index Terms
- AND filter by APA PsycTests Classification Code: 5900: Education, Teaching, and Student Characteristics

This search strategy provides 631 relevant results, including:
